For those dates listed above, the CBP offices located on the first floor at 423 Canal Street, New Orleans, Louisiana will be closed due to traffic congestion associated with Mardi Gras. During this time the CBP Marine Division, Operations Desk and PAU staff will relocate to the CBP offices at the Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.

As a reminder, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays do not count when calculating timeframes for:

- Vessel formal entrance after arrival [48 hours] (19 CFR 4.3a);
- Vessel departures after CBP clearance is granted [48 hours] (19 CFR 4.60d);
- Filing complete manifests and export declarations [4 days] (19CFR 4.75b).
